MOMENT OF SILENCE

- **Community Guests.** Honor Council was pleased to welcome Marisa Militello, '08. The majority of every Council meeting is open to the community and we welcome everybody. Next week's meeting will be visited by an entire customs group and its HCOs.
- **Ratification Cards.** The numbers are in. The Haverford Students' Association ratified the Honor Code by 9 votes. Some concerns raised were:
 - Brandon: Too much wasted paper
 - Emily: Felt awkward watching people vote at the same table
 - Travis: Soliciting ballots after tabling is over
 - Julien: Content of email asking students for ratification cards
 - Oleg: Cards were distributed too early in mail
- **Council Librarian.** As passed by Plenary, SC must appoint the Librarian this semester. Brandon Auerbach, '07, has requested Council prepare information for the Appointments Committee. Travis suggested Council form a committee to write up the requirements of the position. Nitro, Lindsey, Emily and Travis volunteered to sit on the committee. They will meet once this week and report back to Council.
- **JSAAPP and Quaker Bouncers.** Discussion centered around recent reports about the number of visitors for whom students are vouching at Haverford parties. Council discussed the responsibility of students vouching for guests and our obligations to the Honor Code.
 - Jacob and Lindsey: Concerned about lack of student input in any current proposed changes in the process
 - Julien: Suggested community members read Peanuts
 - Emily: It is untrusting to limit community members to 5 guests
- **Faculty Meeting.** Julien and Oleg reported on the Faculty meeting. They presented last semester's abstracts to the Faculty and suggested Council and the Faculty open dialogue about making fulfillment of resolutions a graduation requirement. Council discussed how it needs to have a better relationship with the faculty and the students.
 - Julien: Council needs to hold a mock trial.
 - Emily: There is a rift between Council and the students as illustrated by Plenary.
- **Diversity Training.** Council discussed different proposals for a diversity training. Julien and Oleg are contacting OMA for advice.
