Some of the questions raised are whether or not Honor Council should facilitate a dialogue about the lack of debate or presentation of the policy, if people are well enough informed about the Policy, if there is dialogue about this issue and if it is our job to create dialogue about it, whether or not this is JSAAPP's job, and what the efficiency of starting a dialogue now would be in relation to the timing of Plenary. Council ends up deciding not to take action on the matter, but that if the issue rises again we are open to talking about it more and possibly becoming involved if we decide it is our place to do so.

C. Nick has been working on password-protecting the abstracts on our website so that students and people on the Haverford network can still access them, rather than removing them from the website altogether. (The College's lawyers have told us we shouldn't have them available on the website, so this is a compromise we came up with.)
